Year 5 – Belgium

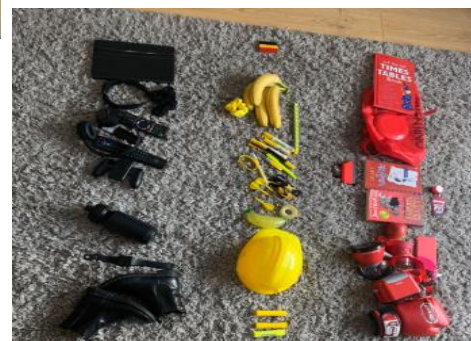
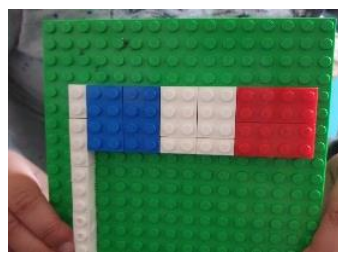
Year 6 - Vietnam

To start the theme week we learnt about all of the different countries where they speak French around the world. There are 29 in total! Then there was a whole school assembly explaining the tasks.



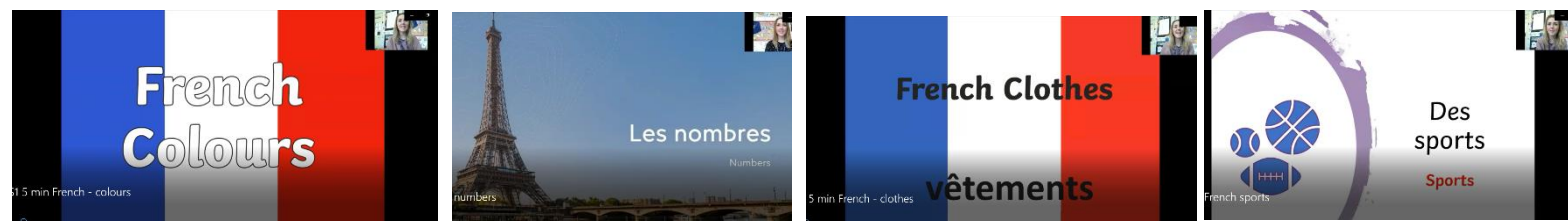
The children were set online learning on Tapestry and SeeSaw. Look at their amazing work (at both home and school)...

RECREATING THE FLAG



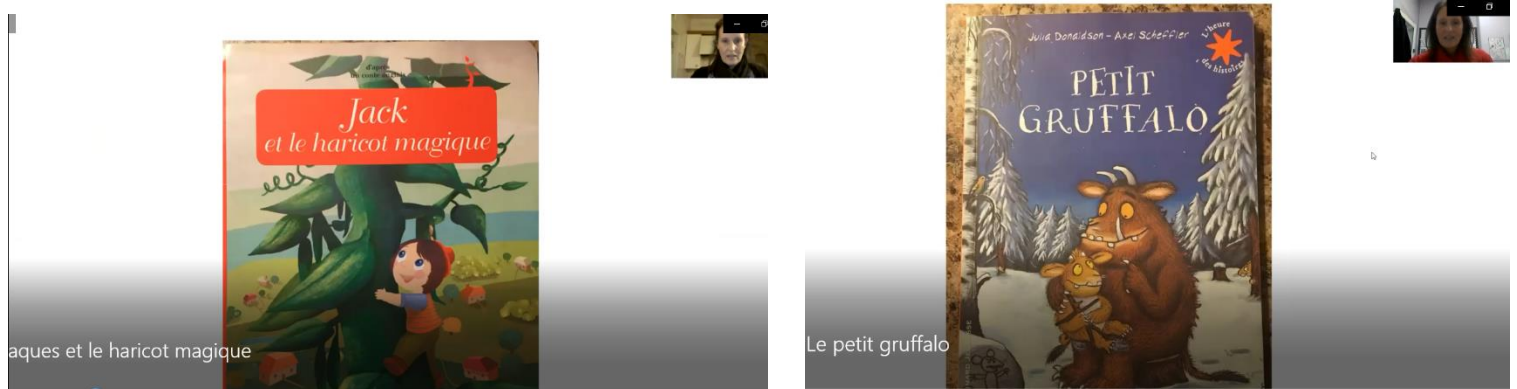
5 MINUTE FRENCH LESSONS
