Our Greggs Breakfast Club goes from strength to strength – this is open to all families from 8.30am-8.40am.

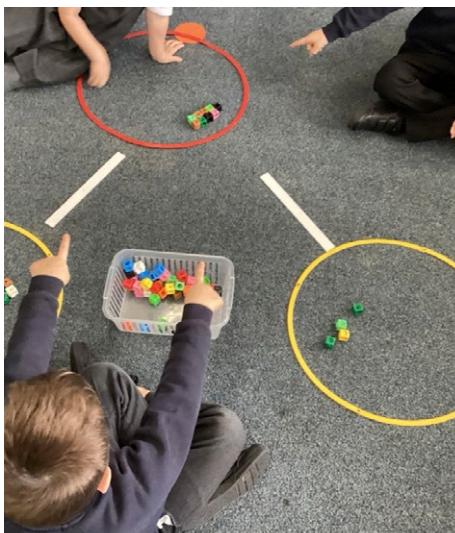
It is lovely to see the school community socialising and ensuring they are fully fuelled and ready for the school day. A huge thank you to the staff who volunteer and make this happen each day.
