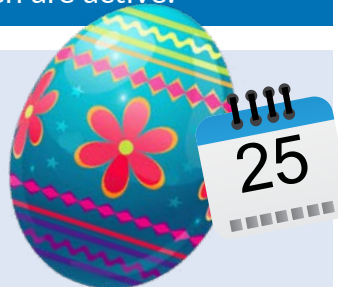


London Marathon Markings
